EBIS/T Science Program

The EBIS/T 2022 program will cover fundamental topics of EBIS/T science and technology:

- EBIS/T physics including electron and ion beam optics and related simulations
- EBIS charge state breeder developments and operational experience
- Charge breeding of stable and radioactive isotopes
- Atomic spectroscopy of highly charged ions
- Applications of highly charged ions from EBIS/T

- Projected attendance: 60-80 ppl
- We expect a majority will be local
- Contract for venue has wording to support cancellation if travel is restricted due to COVID
